LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

The Catholic Church has always believed and taught that Jesus Christ is really truly present in the sacrament of the Eucharist. This makes the sacrament of the Eucharist the greatest of all sacraments. Here's how the Catechism puts it: *"In the most blessed sacrament of the Eucharist the body and blood, together with the soul and divinity, of our Lord Jesus Christ and, therefore, the whole Christ is truly, really, and substantially contained"* (#1374). That means that the Eucharist is not just a symbol of Christ's presence. A symbol points to a reality, like the paschal lamb in the Old Testament pointed towards the Lamb of God in the New Testament, Jesus Christ, or like an exit sign on the freeway points towards a road or a town. Most non-Catholic Christians believe that the Eucharist is like that, just a symbol of Christ's presence, not the real thing.

But as Catholics we know that Christ is not just symbolically present in the Eucharist, he is truly, really present as also the Orthodox Christians believe. That's what makes the Eucharist a sacrament, instead of just a symbol. This is why St Paul, in today's Second Reading, calls Holy Communion a "participation" in the body and blood of Christ. And this is why Jesus himself, in today's Gospel Reading, repeats six times - SIX times - in just seven verses, that his flesh is real food and his blood is real drink.

Every time an ordained priest pronounces the words of consecration at Mass - when he says, *"this is my body... this is my blood"* - Jesus himself, in a mysterious, sacramental way, becomes truly present under the appearances of bread and wine. This is what Jesus taught, and this is what Catholics have believed since the very dawn of the Church. And so, every time Mass is celebrated, whether on a battlefield, in a hospital, in the jungle, or right here in our parish church, a real miracle occurs. Just as Jesus turned water into wine at the wedding feast in Cana, at every Mass he turns bread and wine into his own body and blood. Only God can do that kind of thing - only God can perform miracles.

That's why although we know that it happens, we don't understand exactly how it happens. Theologians can only describe what happens. They call it "transubstantiation." This means that during the Mass, the substance of the bread and wine are changed into Christ's body and blood, but the appearance of bread and wine remains the same. Many times, throughout the history of the Church God has allowed other miracles to take place to remind us of the reality of the central miracle of the Eucharist. There are documented cases of consecrated hosts (the small piece of bread used during the Mass - after it is consecrated by the priest, it becomes the Eucharist) that have begun to bleed, that have turned into flesh, that have been miraculously preserved in the midst of devastating fires. Miracles like these, of which history is full, are just reminders of the main miracle that occurs every day: Christ turning bread and wine into his body and blood. That mystery is what we celebrate today.

CARTA DE NUESTRO PÁRROCO

Queridos Parroquianos,

La iglesia católica siempre ha creído y enseña que Jesucristo está verdaderamente presente en el Sacramento de la Eucaristía. Esto hace que el Sacramento de la Eucaristía sea el mayor de todos los sacramentos. es cómo lo dice el Catecismo: "en el Santísimo Sacramento de la Eucaristía el cuerpo y la sangre, junto con el alma y la divinidad de nuestro Señor Jesucristo y, por lo tanto, todo Cristo es verdadero, real y substancialmente" (#1374). Esto significa que la Eucaristía no es sólo un símbolo de la presencia de Cristo. Un punto de símbolo a una realidad, como el cordero Pascual en el Antiguo Testamento señalaron hacia el cordero de Dios en el nuevo testamento, Jesucristo, o como una salida firme en los puntos de la autovía hacia una carretera o una ciudad. Muchos cristianos no católicos creen que la Eucaristía, es sólo un símbolo de la presencia de Cristo, no la cosa real.

Pero como católicos sabemos que Cristo no está sólo simbólicamente presente en la Eucaristía, está verdaderamente, realmente presente como también los cristianos ortodoxos creen. Es lo que hace a la Eucaristía un Sacramento, en vez de sólo un símbolo. Por esta razón San Pablo, en la segunda lectura de hoy, le llama Santa Comunión una "participación" en el cuerpo y la sangre de Cristo. Y por eso mismo, Jesús en el Evangelio de hoy, repite seis veces - seis veces - en tan solo siete versículos, que su carne es verdadera comida y su sangre es verdadera bebida. Cada vez que un sacerdote ordenado pronuncia las palabras de la consagración en la Misa - cuando dice "Esto es mi cuerpo... esta es mi sangre" - Jesús, de un modo misterioso, sacramental, se hace verdaderamente presente bajo las apariencias del pan y del vino. Esto es lo que enseñó Jesús, y esto es lo que los católicos han creído desde el mismo amanecer de la iglesia. Y así, cada vez que se celebra la Misa, ya sea en un campo de batalla, en un hospital, en la selva, o bien aquí en nuestra iglesia parroquial, un verdadero milagro se produce. Así como Jesús convirtió agua en vino en las bodas de Cana, en cada Misa convierte pan y el vino en su cuerpo y sangre. Sólo Dios puede hacer ese tipo de cosas - sólo Dios puede realizar milagros.

Es por eso, aunque sabemos lo que sucede, no entendemos exactamente cómo sucede. Teólogos sólo pueden describir lo que sucede. Lo llaman "transubstanciación." Esto significa que, durante la Misa, se cambió la sustancia del pan y el vino en cuerpo y sangre de Cristo, pero la apariencia de pan y el vino sigue siendo el mismo. Muchas veces a lo largo de la historia de la iglesia Dios ha permitido muchos milagros para recordarnos la realidad del milagro central de la Eucaristía. Hay casos documentados de las hostias consagradas (el pequeño pedazo de pan, utilizada durante la Misa - después de que está consagrado por el sacerdote, se convierte en la

Eucaristía) que han empezado a sangrar, que se han convertido en carne, que se han conservado milagrosamente en medio de incendios devastadores. Milagros como éstos, de que la historia es completa, son solo recuerdos del principal milagro que ocurre todos los días: convertir el pan y el vino en su cuerpo y sangre de Cristo. Ese misterio es lo que celebramos hoy.

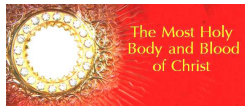

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM – For children to be baptized at St. Jerome, parents must first call the parish office to register for baptism classes, held monthly in English and Spanish. Baptisms are held on the 1st and 2nd Wednesday of the month for Spanish and the 1st Wednesday of the month for English. *Parents of children to be baptized must be registered parishioners.*
