Listen how Jesus is calling you to live the extraordinary life He has in mind for you.

LETTER FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

When faced with difficulties and turmoil believers often seek out the Lord, but many today only resort to faith and prayer as a last resort when all else fails. The readings remind us that seeking God’s presence should be our first instinct in all matters, big and small. In today’s 1st Reading Elijah has made a tiring pilgrimage to Mount Horeb to consult God when his life is endangered by the evil Jezebel. Forty days and nights before reaching

Horeb Elijah had worked a great sign showing the Lord was God, had overthrown a veritable army of false prophets, and witnessed a long, punitive drought that was imposed on the unfaithful Israelites ended. Despite this, his life was in danger, and it seemed the evil and infidelity in Israel was as strong and powerful as ever, led by Jezebel, who pledged to kill after he’d humiliated her prophets and pagan religion. He considered himself a failure and just wanted to sit beneath a tree and die. Yet the Lord’s messenger urged him to make the long pilgrimage to Mount Horeb, the “mountain of God.” Upon arrival, the Lord invites Elijah to explore his motivations for coming and then orders him to leave the cave in which he’d taken refuge and stand in his presence. Elijah knows the Lord is not to be found in the earthquake, the fire, or any other displays or “special effects.” He reacts at the quietest of noises, knowing the Lord is there. When we’re faced with turmoil, we too need to ignore the fanfare of the situation and seek a moment of quiet. That’s where we’ll find the Lord. It may take time and sacrifice, but the Lord will reveal himself.

In today’s Second Reading Paul laments that Israel had received so much from the Lord but failed to recognize the Messiah when he came to them. The Messiah, their Savior, was their own flesh and blood, yet they didn’t recognize him when he finally came. John in the prologue to his Gospel said, “He was in the world, and the world came to be through him, but the world did not know him. He came to what was his own, but his people did not accept him. But to those who did accept him, he gave power to become children of God” (Jn.1:10-12). Many Israelites did not recognize him as Messiah or as God. This should be a warning for us too. We have so much in the Church and have inherited so much from the Jews, but we must always remember who is behind them: Our Lord. They are ways of connecting or reconnecting with him. We’re adopted as sons and daughters of God through Christ. We receive glory through him, worship him, and follow his teachings and trust in his promises. Let’s not squander the gifts by forgetting their Giver.

In today’s Gospel the disciples were sent by Our Lord into what soon became stormy waters, and when he approached them, they thought they were doomed because they didn’t recognize him. The disciples saw a ghost and thought it was a sign that they’d soon be ghosts too. After all the miracles Our Lord had already performed you’d think walking on water would not have been that shocking to them. Our Lord has to encourage them: “Take courage, it is I; do not be afraid.” Peter takes a risk and takes a step out of the boat and into the storm because he believed Our Lord was there and would help him. He takes one step, two steps, three steps, then the wind starts to howl, and his feet start to sink in the water. Our Lord did not let him drown, and he will not let us drown either if we turn to him in faith. As long as we’re on good terms with Our Lord in a life of grace, the Lord dwells inside us. Even when we’re not, he is near, always ready to reconnect. If you want to be able to seek out the Lord in stormy moments, foster the habit of seeking him out in calm ones as well. When things are going well, thank him. When life is not full of earth-shattering events, talk to him. Friends talk about everything no matter what the circumstances. Take a moment sometime this week to foster an awareness of Our Lord’s presence in your soul and speak with him. If you’re burdened by some sin that has distanced you from Our Lord, seek him in the sacrament of Reconciliation.

CARTA DE NUESTRO PÁRROCO

Queridos Parroquianos,

Cuando se enfrentan con dificultades y confusión los creyentes buscan a menudo al Señor, pero muchos hoy en día sólo recurren a la fe y la oración como último recurso cuando todo lo demás falla. Las lecturas nos recuerdan que buscar la presencia de Dios debe ser nuestro primer instinto en todos los asuntos, grandes y pequeños. En la primera lectura de hoy. Elías ha hecho un agotador peregrinaje al Monte Horeb para consultar a Dios cuando su vida estaba en peligro por el mal de Jezabel. Cuarenta días y cuarenta noches antes de llegar a Horeb Elías había trabajado un gran signo que muestra que el Señor es Dios, y había derrocado un ejército verdadero de los falsos profetas y fue testigo de una sequía larga, punitiva que se impuso a los israelitas infieles que termino. A pesar de esto, su vida estaba en peligro y le pareció que el mal y la infidelidad de Israel era tan fuerte y potente como siempre, conducido por Jezabel, se comprometió a matar después de humillar sus profetas y su religión pagana. Él se consideraba un fracaso y sólo quería sentarse debajo de un árbol y morir. Sin embargo, el Mensajero de Dios le instó a hacer el largo peregrinaje al Monte Horeb, "Monte de Dios." A su llegada, el Señor invita a Elías para explorar sus motivaciones para venir y luego le ordena abandonar la cueva en que él había tomado refugio y estar en su presencia. Elías sabe que al Señor no debe ser encontrado en el terremoto, el fuego, o cualquier otra muestra o "efectos especiales". El resalta en las cosas tranquilas sin ruidos, sabiendo que el Señor está allí. Cuando enfrentamos alguna agitación, tenemos que ignorar la fanfarria de la situación y buscar un momento de tranquilidad. Es donde encontramos al Señor. Puede tomar tiempo y sacrificio, pero el Señor se revelará.

En la segunda lectura de hoy Pablo lamenta que Israel hubiera recibido tanto del Señor, pero no pudieron reconocer al Mesías cuando vino a ellos. El Mesías, su Salvador, era su propia carne y sangre, pero ellos no le reconocieron cuando él finalmente llegó. Juan en el prólogo de su evangelio dijo, "estaba en el mundo y el mundo llegó a ser a través de él, pero el mundo no lo conocía. Él vino a lo suyo, pero su pueblo no lo aceptara. Pero a los que le aceptaron, les dio poder para ser hijos de Dios"(Jn.1:10-12). Muchos israelitas no lo reconocían como Mesías o Dios. Esto debería ser una advertencia para nosotros también. Tenemos tanto en la iglesia y hemos heredado gran parte de los judíos, pero debemos recordar siempre quién está detrás de ellos: nuestro Señor. Son maneras de conectar o reconectar con él. Estamos adoptados como hijos e hijas de Dios por medio de Cristo. Recibimos gloria por medio de él, lo adoramos y seguimos sus enseñanzas y confiamos en sus promesas. Vamos a no desperdiciar los dones olvidándonos de quien es el donante.

En el evangelio los discípulos fueron enviados por nuestro Señor en lo que pronto se convirtió en aguas turbulentas, y

cuando él se aproximó a ellos, pensaban que estaban condenados porque no le reconocieron. Los discípulos vieron a un fantasma y pensaban que era una señal de que pronto serían fantasmas también. Después de todos los milagros que nuestro Señor ya había realizado uno pensaría no caminar sobre el agua habría sido algo arrogante. Nuestro Señor tiene que animarlos: "ánimo, soy yo; no tengas miedo." Pedro toma el riesgo y da un paso fuera del barco en la tormenta porque creía que nuestro Señor estaba allí y le ayudaría. Da un paso, dos pasos, tres pasos, luego el viento comienza a gritar, y sus pies comienzan a hundirse en el agua. Nuestro Señor no le dejó ahogar, y no se nos dejan ahogar si nos volvemos a él con fe. Cuando estamos en buenos términos con nuestro Señor en vida de gracia, el Señor habita dentro de nosotros. Incluso cuando no lo estamos, él está cerca, siempre listo para volver a conectar. Si usted es capaz de buscar al Señor en momentos tormentosos, fomentar el hábito de buscarlo en la calma también. Cuando las cosas van bien, agradecerle. Cuando la vida no está llena de acontecimientos trascendentales, hablar con él. Amigos hablen de todo sin importar las circunstancias. Tome un tiempo en algún momento esta semana para fomentar una conciencia de la presencia de nuestro Señor en su alma y hable con él. Si usted está agobiado por algún pecado que ha alejado de nuestro Señor, búsquelo en el Sacramento de la reconciliación.

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM – For children to be baptized at St. Jerome, parents must first call the parish office to register for baptism classes, held monthly in English and Spanish.
